



I MEDITERRANEAN CONTEST FOR THE PROMOTION OF OLIVE TREE CULTURE

Recomed recognize and value the works and actions of promotion and dissemination of the Olive Culture, as well as stimulating its development.

The awarding of the prizes will be governed by the following bases:

1st Candidacy

- Own candidacy.- All individuals and public or private entities that consider having carried out relevant work in any aspect related to the promotion and dissemination of the culture of the olive tree and present their candidacy will be eligible for the Prize.
- Candidature of others.- In addition, candidates submitted by other people will be accepted, provided that they have the authorization of the author of the work so that, in case of being awarded, accept the prize and make the decision public.

In the same way, the award may be granted to certain experiences, works or persons who, even though they have not submitted their candidacy, the Jury believes that they are worthy of it, due to their extraordinary merits or because they have been proposed by other persons or organizations.

2nd Themes

The topics should preferably deal with the natural, historical and touristic environment of the olive grove, communication, education, new technologies, gastronomy and others of considered relevance for the promotion of the culture of the olive grove.

3th Requirements and deadlines for submission

The works submitted to the contest may be finalized or be experiences in execution, but future projects will not be evaluated.

It is essential the registration form for each application duly completed. Three copies of the publications or works must be submitted, together with photographs, audiovisuals, etc., with which the Award is presented.

The projects must be submitted in an envelope addressed to RECOMED Secretariat with the following indication: "I RECOMED CONTEST OLIVE CULTURE".

4th Prizes

Three prizes may be awarded. Some of them may remain deserted.

The decision of the Jury will be unappealable and will be published on the Association's website: www.recomed.eu and on social networks. The Prize will be awarded at a public ceremony.

Non-awarded works may be withdrawn by their authors or delegates, within a period of two months, starting from the public communication of the decision. If not removed during that time they may be destroyed.

5th The Qualifying Jury

It will be appointed by RECOMED and will be composed of relevant personalities from the world of culture, gastronomy, the university environment and the journalistic and editorial sectors. Its composition will not be made public until after the ruling.

6th Acceptance and Authorization

The presentation to the Prize implies the acceptance of these bases and the authorization for the dissemination of the results in the form in which RECOMED considers appropriate. RECOMED reserves the right to any initiative that is not regulated in these Bases to contribute to the success of the Prize, without any claim against its decisions.
